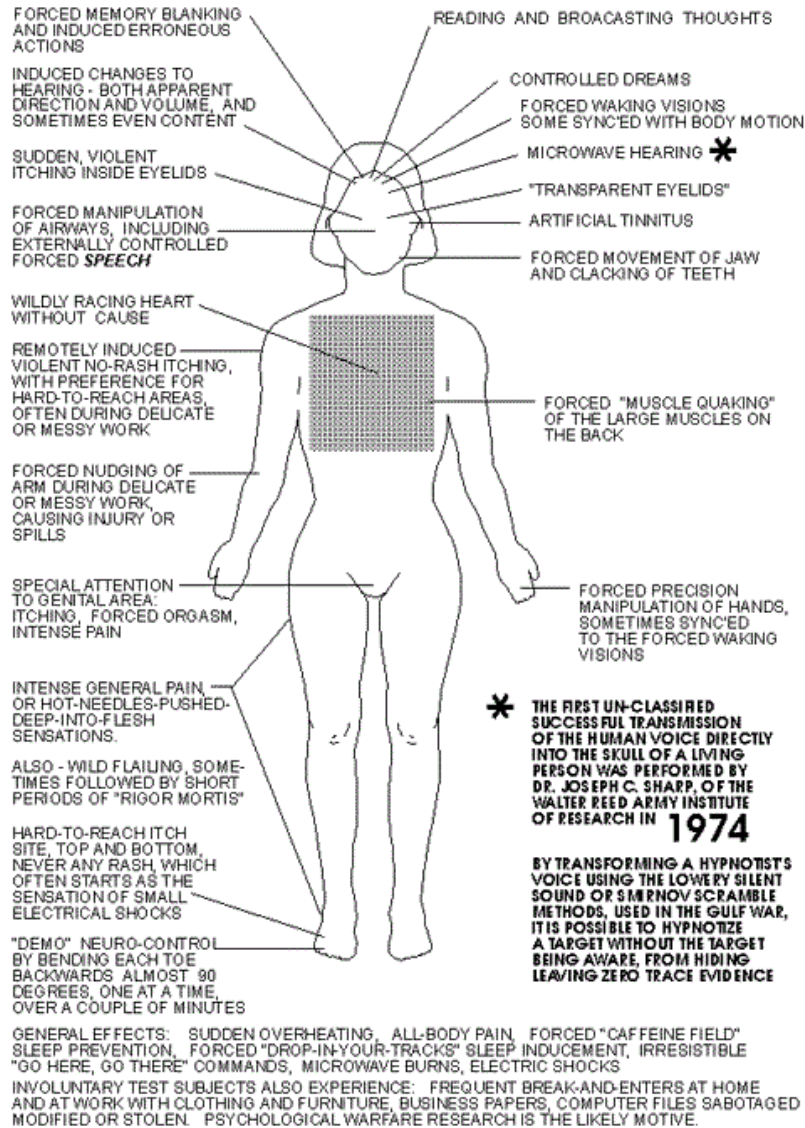


Government Accidentally Releases Documents on "Psycho-Electric" Weapons

The government has all kinds of secrets, but only a true conspiracy theorist might suspect that "psycho-electric weapons" are one of them. So it's odd that MuckRock, a news organization that specializes in filing Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests with state and federal government bodies, received mysterious documents about mind control, seemingly by accident.

Journalist Curtis Waltman was writing to the Washington State Fusion Center (WSFC), a joint operation between Washington State law enforcement and the federal government to request information about Antifa and white supremacist groups. He got responses to the questions he asked, but also a file titled “EM effects on human body.zip.”

NASHVILLE, Tenn. — A detective says the man accused of fatally shooting a woman and wounding six other people at a Tennessee church told him he heard voices and had visions.

In Davidson County General Sessions Court, Nashville Police Detective Steve Jolley also testified Monday about a note in the car of 25-year-old Emanuel Kilega Samson referencing a white supremacist's 2015 massacre at a South Carolina black church, as The Associated Press first reported. Jolley said it read something like, "Dylann Roof was less than nothing."

Jolley also said Samson told him he didn't give much thought to race or religion.
